A Pilot Program



What is a Mobile Hotspot?

With a mobile hotspot, you can connect your wireless enabled electronic device to the Internet!

Who can borrow the hotspots?

Lending is open to Hackensack residents, 18 and older, with a valid Hackensack Library card with no fines or overdue materials. Residents with Courtesy Cards, Pay Cards, or cards newer than 6 months are not eligible to borrow the hotspots.

How long can they be borrowed for?

Mobile hotspots are free to borrow. They can be borrowed for 2 weeks. Devices can be checked out again if no one is on the waiting list. If there are none available, please put your name down for one to be held for you! We will contact you as soon as one becomes available.

The not-so-fine print

There is a \$5 late fee for every day it is not returned on time. Service will be turned off if the hotspot kit is not returned by the due date. Fines will accrue until the device is returned. If the device is lost, stolen, or broken beyond repair, a \$120 fine will be charged to your library account.
