

Johnson Public Library Mobile Hotspot Lending Policy

1. Library patrons who fulfill the age and residency requirements can borrow a Mobile Hotspot Kit for a 2 week loan period.
2. Mobile Hotspot kits can only be checked out and returned at the Johnson Public Library Reference desk, in person, by the individual who is borrowing the kit.
3. There is a \$5 late fee for each day the mobile hotspot kit is not returned on time. Service will be turned off if the kit is not returned by the due date. Fines accrue until the device is returned. If the device is lost, stolen, or broken beyond repair, a \$120 fine will be charged to your library account.
4. The kits must be returned in the condition they were borrowed. Borrower and staff member will go over the kit and all its peripherals at checkout and check-in to make sure everything is in working order.
5. By agreeing to borrow a kit, the borrower is agreeing to take full responsibility for the physical equipment on loan, as well as any and all issues or damages resulting from use of the hotspot kit.
6. The Johnson Public Library is not responsible for any damages resulting from patron use of the kit, including, but not limited to, damage to a computer or other device for which a patron may use the hotspot kit to access the internet, data loss, computer viruses, identity theft, invasion of privacy, or any other damages, which may result from access to and use of the internet.
7. The mobile hotspot kits are an extension of the library internet access, as well as library property. The library policy covering Internet usage applies, specifically sections 2 and 3 listed below:
 - “2. The library internet user must adhere to all laws regarding copyright infringement. Use of Internet for activities that violate local, state, or federal laws is prohibited, including pornography, committing fraud, hacking, harassing others, or libel. Users may not misrepresent themselves when using the library’s internet access.
 3. The Internet is a worldwide computer network with a highly diverse user population. The Johnson Public Library does not monitor or control the information available on the Internet and is not responsible for its quality, accuracy or content. Therefore Library patrons use the Internet and the information and service available on it at their own risk.”
